## Important regulatory features for ETC Programming

- Programme geography mainly based on existing cooperation areas
- Funding for transnational cooperation programmes remains on similar level
- Focus of Europe 2020 agenda: "Growth and jobs"
- Thematic concentration and result orientation
- Simplification and proportionality

# 3. Main Features of the Future Programme

## The Programme will...

- continue in similar geographic set-up
- operate with an at least 20% increased budget
- involve private project partners
- provide up to 75%/85% co-financing on priority axis level
- explore scope for simplification, esp. regarding eligibility of costs and reporting
